

resol RESOLUTION ORDERING VACATION OF A PORTION OF A CERTAIN PUBLIC UTILITY EASEMENT

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSEVILLE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That, proof of publication and posting of Notice of Intention to vacate a portion of a certain public utility easement as hereinbelow described having been received by this Council, and public hearing thereon held as required by law, it is hereby found that the public utility easement hereinbelow described is necessary for present or prospective public use.

2. That it is hereby ordered that that certain portion of a public easement hereinbelow described be and hereby is vacated, which easement is described with common certainty as follows:

"That portion of public utility easement located in the City of Roseville, County of Placer, State of California, further described as: A strip of land 5.0 feet wide, 2.5 feet at right angles to the following described centerline, to wit: Beginning at the point south 77° 37' 30" west 8.0 feet from the northeast corner of Lot 2, being also the southeast corner of Lot 3 as shown on the plat of Sierra Gardens Unit No. 9, recorded in Book G of Maps, Map No. 52, Placer County records, thence from said point of beginning south 77° 37' 30" west along the line between said Lots 2 and 3 to a point on said line at the intersection of the easterly line of an 8.0 foot public utility easement running parallel to and 8.0 feet distant from the northeasterly right of way line of Cindy Circle as shown on said plat of Sierra Gardens Unit No. 9."

3. That the City Clerk is directed to cause a certified copy of this order, attested by said Clerk under the seal of the City of Roseville, to be recorded in the Office of the Placer County Recorder.

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSEVILLE APPROVING AN INTERIM OPEN SPACE PLAN - GENERAL GOALS AND POLICIES AND ACTION PROGRAM
