PERMIT

Permission is hereby granted to Bill Zisk for maintenance work on Dry Creek on his property as shown on the attached drawing. The work in general is to consist of removing of a sand bar and sloping of the existing creek channel to a flatter grade. The material removed from these excavations shall be placed in an old stream channel running parallel to the existing channel. The work is further shown on the attached drawing. All work is to be done in conformance with the attached Fish and Game Permit, signed by Bill Zisk on June 1st, 1973, Fish and Game Notification No. II-86-73. This permit for Channel Maintenance shall expire October 1, 1973. Any filling done under this permit shall not exceed the existing improved embankment as shown on the attached sketch and such fills shall not be utilized for structures. Any filling intended for structures shall be utilized under the provisions of the Uniform Building Code.
