Dear Mr. Bronson:

Attached is a proposed parcel map of the Bill Zisk property encroaching the Dry Creek flood plain north of Station 81, Plate 6 of your report, "Flood Plain Information - Dry Creek and Tributaries, Roseville, California."

The finished contour as shown on the site and grading plan appears to be affecting the primary floodway, resulting in increasing flow velocity, possible erosion of adjoining land and backwater effect on upstream properties, which, of course, are detrimental to the health, safety and general welfare of the public.

Therefore, we are withholding the processing of the proposed parcel map, and respectfully request your District for a specific study on the effect of such grading plan on flow velocity, erosion, backwater effect and other sound flood plain management consideration of Dry Creek.
