A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSEVILLE ADOPTING AN OPEN-SPACE AND CONSERVATION ELEMENT OF THE CITY OF ROSEVILLE GENERAL PLAN

Whereas, the planning agency of the City of Roseville has caused to be prepared long term Open-Space and Conservation Elements to the General Plan for the physical development of the City and of the land outside its boundaries which, in the judgment of the planning agency, bears a relation to its planning; and

Whereas, during the formulation of the Open-Space and Conservation Elements of the General Plan, the planning agency has consulted and advised with public officials and agencies, public utilities, civic, educational, professional and other organizations and citizens generally to the end that maximum coordination of plans were secured and properly located sites for all public purposes are indicated on the elements; and

Whereas, the planning agency has referred the Open-Space and Conservation Elements to other planning agencies as prescribed by law; and

Whereas, the Planning Commission has held public hearings on the adoption of the Open-Space and Conservation Elements to the General Plan and has given all interested persons an opportunity to be heard; and

Whereas, the Planning Commission of the City of Roseville, by Resolution PC 73-2, approved the Open-Space and Conservation Elements to the General Plan on May 10, 1973,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSEVILLE,

That the Open-Space and Conservation Elements to the General Plan prepared by the Planning Department of the City of Roseville, entitled "CITY OF ROSEVILLE OPEN-SPACE AND CONSERVATION ELEMENT", dated May 10, 1973, is hereby adopted.
